- notations and instructions -

PLAYER 1 (student):

low triangle

set up (suspended cymbal, cowbell, 4 templeblocs, floor tom)

marimba (low A)

4 timpani

vibraphone

snare drum

xylophone (to be played on the marimba if no xylophone available)

PLAYER 2 (teacher):

high triangle

snare drum

marimba (low A)

suspended cymbal, 4 timpani

tambourine
